WICHITA ART MUSEUM

Welcome! Please observe the following special facility guidelines:

- Guests may not touch, handle, or move any artwork
- Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times
- Food and drinks are not allowed in the galleries
- Food and drinks may not be taken outside the Naftzger Room or Brasted Board Room
- No Post-it Notes or tape allowed on cabinetry housing art in the Naftzger Room or Brasted Board Room
- Alcoholic beverages may not be brought into the museum
- Alcohol, glass bottles, and drinkware may not be taken outside of the museum
- Champagne is only allowed to be opened inside the Muse Cafe
- The museum is a smoke-free facility; smoking is allowed outside in designated areas only
- · Chewing tobacco, vapor materials, E-cigarettes, and cigars are not allowed in the museum
- No flash photography or tripod cameras are allowed in the galleries
- Running, jumping, dancing, eating, drinking, and shoes are not allowed on the Chihuly Bridge
- Glitter, rice, confetti, and other small particle items are not allowed
- Balloons are not allowed in the museum
- Potted plants are not allowed in the museum
- Fog/smoke machines are not allowed in the museum
- Party favors are not allowed to be tossed inside the museum
- All musical entertainment must keep the volume under 90 decibels to prevent damage to art
- The Lattner & Walker Family Plaza is a fire lane and should only be used for pick-up and drop-off; unauthorized vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense
- All vendors must enter through the dock on the north side of the museum, and must check in and out with security
- No equipment may be loaded or unloaded through the museum front entrance
- Vehicles are not allowed to remain parked in the loading dock during an event
- Works of art may not be photographed for reproduction
- Walking in Art Garden planting beds, central mound, and Pulse Field is prohibited
- Trees, plants, and flowers in the Art Garden may not be removed, trimmed, or cut without the written consent of the museum director
